MONTHLY PLAN

Effective active teaching months would be 8 months (4 classes in a month), that's 32 weeks or classes in a year. All books have a range of 43 to 44 topics. One class in a month can be Topical Learning.

In totality, each month can accommodate around 5 to 6 topics.
